LAUNCHING OF WEEK OF ETHICAL VALUES

SAN SALVADOR– During a press conference held today, the President of the Board of Directors of the Salvadoran Foundation for Economic and Social Development (FUSADES), Antonio Cabrales, and the Executive Director of the National Foundation for Development (FUNDE), Roberto Rubio, launched the Week of Ethical Values.

This initiative has been organized by the Transparency and Governance Program and funded by the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID) and the U.S. Embassy Public Affairs Office, with support from FUSADES and FUNDE.

The Week of Ethical Values, that will take place in San Salvador from September 25 through 29, is aimed at raising awareness among different sectors of Salvadoran society about the practice of ethical values.

During the Week of Ethical Values, a selected group of national and international speakers will offer a series of workshops, conferences and training sessions to public employees, members of the civil society, non-government organizations, journalists, representatives from the private sector, professors and students. The purpose is to promote dialogue on ethical values, present the new Government Ethics Law, and connect its application with international tools such as the Inter-American Convention Against Corruption (CICC).
