

## USAID Development Grants Program for East Africa

USAID/East Africa is pleased to inform you that the U.S. Government through the U.S. Agency for International Development's Office of Development Partners (ODP) has issued a Request for Applications (RFA) for its 2011 Development Grants Program (DGP) in line with Agency priorities and initiatives, *utilizing new partners*.

The purpose of the DGP is to create new partnerships between USAID and NGOs that have had limited or no prior funding from and experience working directly with USAID. A key goal of the DGP is to expand USAID's NGO network of development partners and provide capacity building support to the new partners. In doing so, USAID will enable a wider range of partners to better meet their constituents' needs and contribute to development outcomes.

The RFA encourages applicants to propose effective, innovative approaches that contribute to the achievement of development objectives in targeted sectors. The USAID Mission to East Africa is accepting applications in two of these sectors: **water** and **climate change adaptation**. Please refer to the mission-specific guidelines in Attachment 01 for more information on the types of activities USAID/East Africa would like to support.
